

## MINUTES OF THE HOUSTON COUNTY COMMISSION

Emergency Meeting

March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020

PRESENT: Chairman Mark Culver, Commissioner Doug Siquefield, Commissioner Ricky Herring, County Attorney Pres Register, and Chief Administrative Officer Peter Covert.

Chairman Culver called to order the Emergency Meeting for March 19, 2020. Commissioner Herring gave the invocation and Chairman Culver declared a quorum as a majority was present.

### AGENDA

1. Consider and adopt a resolution to suspend in-person proceedings at county buildings

Chairman Culver began by stating that there was one item to address during this meeting and that is to consider and adopt a resolution to suspend in-person proceedings at all county buildings.

Chairman Culver read the resolution and asked for comments. Pres Register, County Attorney, commented that the last of the resolution states that items that are necessary by law, which is handed down from the Supreme Court, will still be handled as usual at the Court House. At the county buildings, there will not be any in-person interactions with county employees, but the public's business will continue to be transacted as best as possible. Chairman Culver asked for a motion to adopt the resolution (attached to original minutes) Commissioner Siquefield made a motion and Commissioner Herring seconded the motion. After a call for the question, the motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Culver stated that there is a commission meeting scheduled for April 13<sup>th</sup>, but if necessary, an emergency meeting can be called or a special meeting with five days notice.
