

MINUTES OF THE HOUSTON COUNTY COMMISSION
REGULAR SESSION
February 8, 2021

PRESENT: Chairman Mark S. Culver, Commissioner Doug Sinquefield, Commissioner Ricky Herring, County Engineer Barkley Kirkland, Chief Administrative Officer Peter Covert and County Attorney Pres Register.

Chairman Culver welcomed everyone to the February 8th, 2021, Houston County Commission Regular Session and called the 10:00 a.m. meeting to order. He declared a quorum as a majority of the commissioners were in attendance. He also welcomed everyone that was watching the meeting via ZOOM.

The invocation was given by Chairman Culver and Commissioner Sinquefield led in the pledge of allegiance.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved on a motion by Commissioner Herring and seconded by Commissioner Sinquefield. The motion passed unanimously.
